Everyone enjoyed their



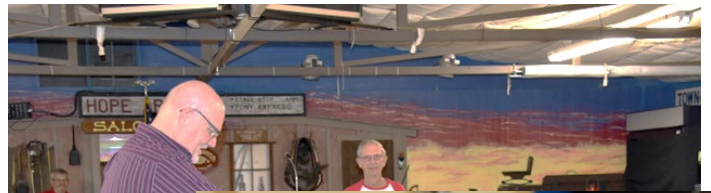
dinner; we all then went back to the park for some Left Right Center.

On Saturday morning we had a pancake breakfast made by the park, with sausage and scrambled eggs.



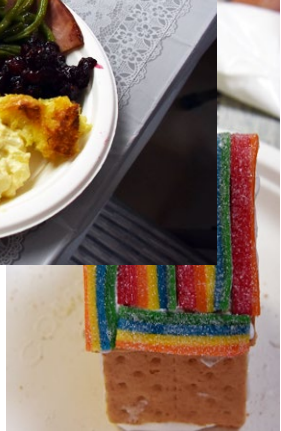
Virginia brought the makings for us to assemble graham cracker houses. It was great fun.



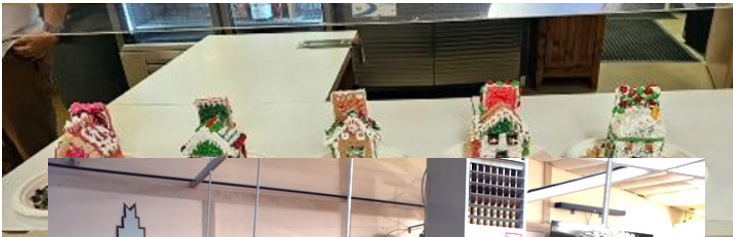
There was a total of 5 Ginger Bread (Graham Cracker) houses created. What great talent in the

Saturday night we had a potluck with ham, potato salad, scalloped potatoes, two types of



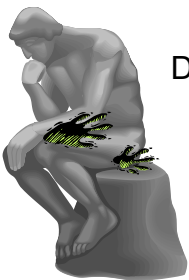
green beans, pineapple stuffing, broccoli salad,

Cherry Vanilla Heaven Desert

Ingredients:

Cake

1 whole Angel Food Cake

Pudding

1 package (3/4 ounces) instant vanilla Pudding

1 1/2 cups 2% or whole milk

1 cup heavy cream

Toppings

1 can (21 ounces) cherry pie filling

8 ounces whipped topping (such as cool whip)

1/2 cup slivered almonds, for topping (optional)

Directions:

Cut angel food cake into cubes. (This was by far the most time-consuming part of the entire recipe. Take your time and use a good serrated knife)

Pudding:



In a large bowl combine vanilla pudding, milk, and heavy cream. Using a hand-held mixer, beat on medium-high for 2 minutes. Set aside

Assemble the Dessert:

1. In a 9x13-inch baking dish, arrange 1/2 of the angel food cake cubes in a layer.
2. Drop half of the cherry pie filling over top of the angel food cake cubes.
3. Spoon vanilla pudding over the filling and spread evenly.
4. Arrange the other half of the angel food cake cubes on top of the vanilla pudding layer.
5. Carefully spread the remaining cherry pie filling over the angel food cake cubes.
6. Top it off with the whipped topping and slivered almonds (optional)
7. Place in the refrigerator for 3-4 hours. Serve cold.

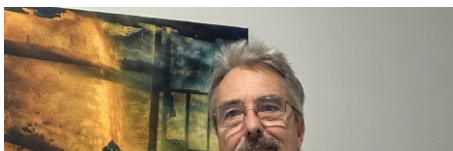

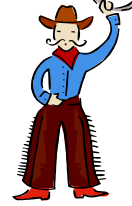
